



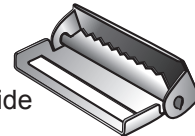

Dritz® Sewing: Suspender Slides (item #203)

The parts:

Each suspender slide set includes two Adjustable Slides.

Suspender Slide

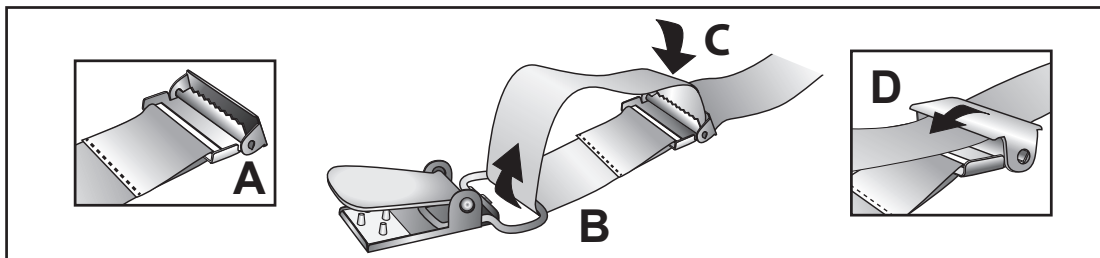


What is a Suspender Slide?

It is a strap adjuster designed to keep suspender straps in place and secure. Slides make suspenders adjustable because they move easily on the suspender strap, and then fold down to lock in place.

How do you use a Suspender Slide?

1. Two suspender slides are used to make a pair of suspenders, along with 4 suspender clips and 2 pieces of 1-inch wide elastic. Cut elastic and apply Fray Check® to edges to prevent raveling. Insert 1 elastic end, wrong side up, through open end of suspender slide from back to front. Extend elastic about 3/4" beyond slide. Stitch elastic close to raw edge (A).
2. Thread opposite end of elastic through suspender clip loop from back to front (B). Insert elastic end through suspender slide again, passing it over the teeth and under the cap of the slide (C). Pull elastic to desired length. Fold down the cap of the slide to lock in place (D).



3. Insert remaining elastic end through a second suspender clip from front to back. Extend elastic about 3/4" and stitch as in step 1.
4. Make a second elastic strap as above. Pin straps so they cross over in the back and stitch. Attach clips to waistband; adjust slides to fit. See makesomething.dritz.com for more details on measuring and finishing elastic suspenders.
